



READ THE BIBLE IN A YEAR

Writing at the end of 1842, Robert Murray M'Cheyne tells his flock: "It has long been in my mind to prepare a scheme of Scripture reading, in which as many as were made willing by God might agree, so that the whole Bible might be read once by you in the year, and all might be feeding in the same portion of the green pasture at the same time." The Calendar gives four portions (usually four chapters) for each day of the year: two for family worship, morning and evening, and two for private reading, morning and evening. In this way, the entire Bible is read once and the New Testament and Psalms twice in the course of a year. These free Daily Bible Reading Calendars are available at the Information Counter. The reading plan is also available in our mobile app.

THE GOSPEL PROJECT FOR KIDS The next unit of The Gospel Project ("Out of Egypt") will begin January 19. "Out of Egypt" helps kids discover God's amazing provision and protection. God used Joseph to provide for the Israelites, setting the stage for a glorious demonstration of God's power to deliver. God raised up Moses to rescue His people from bondage in Egypt. He saved them from physical captivity like He would one day save His people from spiritual captivity by sending Jesus, a Deliverer greater than Moses. As the people of Israel traveled toward the promised land, God made a covenant with them and instructed them how to live holy lives in an unholy world. God also gave them rules for worship. God's law sustained their relationship with God until His perfect plan was revealed through Jesus Christ. Sessions include Bible stories from Genesis, Exodus, and Leviticus. ONLINE CHURCH DIRECTORY Calvary Chapel of Delta does not have a formal membership or membership process. If you are a believer in Jesus Christ, you are a member of His body, the church. If you regularly attend Calvary Chapel of Delta, and are involved in fellowship, you are considered a "member" of our local fellowship. CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

SUNDAY MORNING Children (through age 12) should be dropped off at their classrooms up to 15 minutes prior to the start of worship, and picked up at the end of service. They have their own time of group worship during the service.

WEDNESDAY EVENING Children ages 4-12 are dismissed from the sanctuary after worship and announcements. The nursery, toddler room, and 2-3 classrooms are available up to 10 minutes prior to the start of service.

JUNIOR HIGH

SUNDAY MORNING Junior High students (7th-9th grades) meet in the prayer room before the start of the 11 AM service, then join the adults in the sanctuary for worship. When worship ends, they return to the prayer room for Bible study.

WEDNESDAY EVENING Junior High students attend worship in the sanctuary with their families, before being dismissed after worship and announcements. Jr. High then meets in the prayer room for Bible study.

SENIOR HIGH

WEDNESDAY EVENING Senior High (10-12th grades) students attend worship in the sanctuary with their families, before being dismissed after worship and announcements. They then meet in the Gym for Bible study.

SPECIAL NEEDS SERVICE

SUNDAY MORNING During the 11 AM service in the gym, we have a class for those with special needs for the purpose of helping them to know Jesus, and enabling parents and caregivers the opportunity to go to church and participate in worship and fellowship. Registration forms are available at the Information Counter.

GIVING

At Calvary Chapel of Delta, we do not take a formal offering. We hold firm to the Scripture found in 2 Corinthians 9:7, which says, "So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver."
